ORDINANCE Numbered 60

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF P8,000.00 OUT OF THE UNAPPROPRIATED FUNDS OF QUEZON CITY, FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF FIVE NEW INTERMEDIATE CLASSES DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR 1940-41.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Quezon City, in its Resolution No. 92, current series, petitioned the National Assembly for an allotment of P22,000.00 for the operation and maintenance of 20 new primary classes and an aid of P8,000.00 for 5 new intermediate classes in Quezon City during the school year 1940-41;

WHEREAS, in his letter dated July 9, 1940, the Honorable, the Secretary to the President of the Philippines has informed the City Council that the matter of opening of new primary classes not only in Quezon City but also in other places is still under advisement by the Department of Public Instruction;

WHEREAS, the Honorable, the Secretary to the President, in his said letter stated that the amount of P8,000.00 may be taken from the item of P200,000.00 in the General Appropriation Act which is an advance to Quezon City for expenses of administration;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City that:

Section 1. The amount of P8,000.00 is hereby appropriated out of the unappropriated funds of Quezon City, for the operation and maintenance of 5 new intermediate classes in Quezon City during the school year 1940-41.

Section 2. The amount set aside in this ordinance shall be expended solely for the specific purpose authorized in this ordinance and for no other.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
