ORDINANCE Numbered 64

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF
P5,500.00 OUT OF THE UNAPPROPRIATED
FUNDS OF CAGAYAN CITY FOR THE PURCHASE
OF A LOT AND HOUSE IN DILIMAN TO BE
USED AS AN EMERGENCY DISPENSARY AND
FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE NECESSARY
MEDICAL SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, the City Mayor made verbal manifesta-
tions before the City Council that on account of the
increasing number of permanent residents in Cagayan
City as well as the increasing number of laborers in
the public works projects there is an absolute neces-
sity for the maintenance of an emergency dispensary
to attend to the first-aid medical needs of the inha-
bitants;

WHEREAS, the amount of P5,500.00 is necessary
for the purchase of a lot and house and for medical
supplies and equipment to maintain such emergency dis-
pensary;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council
of Cagayan City that:

Section 1. The amount of P5,500.00 is hereby
appropriated out of the unappropriated funds of Cagayan
City for the purchase of a lot and house in Diliman to
be used as an emergency dispensary and for the purchase
of the necessary medical supplies and equipment.

Section 2. The amount set aside in this Ordinance
shall be specifically expended for the purposes autho-
rized therein and for no other.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon
its passage.
