ORDINANCE Numbered 67

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF P100.00 OUT OF THE UNAPPROPRIATED FUNDS OF QUEZON CITY FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO REVOLVERS, COMPLETE WITH HOLSTERS AND BELTS AND OTHER ACCESSORIES, TO BE USED BY THE TWO DETECTIVES OF QUEZON CITY WHO ARE NOT YET EQUIPPED WITH ARMS.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police, in his letter dated July 24, 1940, made manifestations to the City Council that there are two detectives in Quezon City who are not equipped with arms;

NO THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City that:

Section 1. The amount of P100.00 is hereby set aside out of the unappropriated funds of Quezon City for the purchase of two revolvers, complete with holsters and belts and other accessories, to be used by the two detectives above-mentioned.

Section 2. The amount set aside in this Ordinance shall be expended solely for the specific purpose for which authorized.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
