ORDINANCE NUMBER 80 +

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARY OF THE CITY ATTORNEY OF QUEZON CITY AT P4,800.00 PER ANNUM AND THE CONVERSION OF THE POSITION OF ONE LAW CLERK WITH COMPENSATION AT THE RATE OF P1,200.00 PER ANNUM TO THAT OF DEPUTY CITY ATTORNEY WITH COMPENSATION AT THE RATE OF P1,800.00 PER ANNUM.

WHEREAS, no salary has been provided for the position of City Attorney under Ordinance No. 55, otherwise known as the Ordinance "appropriating the necessary expenses of the Government of Quezon City during the fiscal year from July 1, 1940 to June 30, 1941";

WHEREAS, the appointment of Hon. Emilio Abello, who was formerly detailed to Quezon City as City Attorney, to the position of Undersecretary of Justice, gives rise to the vacancy of a position of great responsibilities but without salary;

WHEREAS, Hon. Emilio Abello has recommended that a salary be provided for the position of City Attorney and that the present position of Law Clerk in the same Office be converted to that of Deputy City Attorney;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City that:

Section 1. The salary for the position of the City Attorney be fixed at the rate of P4,800.00 per annum.

Section 2. The position of one Law Clerk at the rate of P1,200.00 per annum provided for in Item 1(3) under the Office of the City Attorney, page 7, of Ordinance No. 55, is hereby suppressed and in lieu thereof the position of one Deputy City Attorney with compensation at the rate of P1,800.00 per annum is hereby created.

Section 3. The City Treasurer is hereby authorized to set aside the amount of P6,400.00 out of the unappropriated funds of Quezon City or as much thereof as may be necessary for the payment of the salaries herein authorized, until the end of the current fiscal year.

Section 4. All the provisions of previous ordinance or Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
