ORDINANCE Numbered 88

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING "SARI-SARI" STORE OWNERS, MANAGERS OR OTHER PERSONS IN CHARGE OF THE SAME TO KEEP OR DEPOSIT WITHIN THE PREMISES OF THEIR RESPECTIVE STORES MORE THAN TWO GALS OF PETROLEUM, ALCOHOL OR ANY LIKE COMBUSTIBLE MATERIAL.

Be it enacted by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for "sari-sari" store owners, managers, or other persons in charge of the same and who are engaged in the sale by retail of such articles or materials like petroleum, alcohol or any like combustible article or material, to keep or deposit or allow or consent to the keeping or depositing within the premises of their respective stores, more than two cans of petroleum, alcohol or any like combustible article or material.

Section 2. Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than Two Hundred Pesos (P200.00) or by imprisonment for not more than Three Months, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the Court.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
