ORDINANCE Numbered 90

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGISTRATION OF
THE OFFSPRING OF LARGE CATTLE IN QUEZON
CITY.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City,
that:

Section 1. "Large cattle" construed.— Large cattle
as herein used, includes the horse, mule, ass, carabao,
or other domesticated member of the bovine family.

Section 2. Registration.— It shall be the duty of
the owner or other person in possession of the off-
spring of any large cattle to register the same in the
Office of the City Treasurer of Quezon City within a
period of thirty (30) days after its birth, if kept
within the limits of said City.

It shall likewise be the duty of any owner or other
person in possession or control of any offspring of cat-
tle born outside of Quezon City but brought within the
limits of the same, to register said offspring or off-
springs within a period of thirty (30) days from the date
they were first brought within the limits of Quezon City.

Section 3. Penalty.— Any violation of the provi-
sions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of
not more than twenty-five pesos or by imprisonment for
not more than ten days or by both such fine and impris-
onment in the discretion of the Court.

Section 4. Effectivity.— This Ordinance shall take
effect upon its passage.
