ORDINANCE Numbered 98

FINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF ₱31.50
FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED FUNDS OF QUEZON CITY
TO COVER THE COST OF ELECTRICAL SERVICES FOR
ONE 60-CANDLE-POWER STREETLIGHT TO BE INSTALLED
AT DATA STREET, STA. MESA HEIGHTS SUBDIVISION,
QUEZON CITY, FOR THE PERIOD FROM OCTOBER, 1940
TO JUNE, 1941, AT ₱3.50 per MONTH.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City,
that:

Section 1. The amount of ₱3150 is hereby set
aside from the unappropriated funds of Quezon City
to cover the cost of electrical services for one
60-candle-power streetlight to be installed at Data
Street, Sta. Mesa Heights Subdivision, Quezon City,
for the period from October, 1940 to June, 1941, at
₱3.50 per month.

Section 2. The sum set aside in this Ordinance
shall be expended solely for the specific purpose for
which authorized and for no other.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect as
of October 1, 1940.
