ORDINANCE Numbered 103

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF P288.00 COLLECTED FROM MATRICULATION FEES IN THE CITY SCHOOLS OF QUEZON CITY FOR THE PURCHASE OF LIBRARY BOOKS AND SUPPLIES AND FOR ATHLETIC SUPPLIES.

WHEREAS, the District Supervisor of Quezon City Schools, in his letter dated October 21, 1940, has informed the City Council that the amount of P288.00 has been collected from the city schools from matriculation fees;

WHEREAS, he has recommended that 60% thereof be appropriated for the purchase of library books and supplies and the rest, or 40%, for athletic supplies;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

Section 1. The amount of P172.80 out of the said sum of P288.00 collected from matriculation fees be as it is hereby appropriated for the purchase of library books and supplies and the balance of P115.20 for athletic supplies, to be used in the schools of Quezon City.

Section 2. The amount set aside in this Ordinance shall be spent solely for the specific purpose for which authorized and for no other.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
