ORDINANCE Numbered 104

AN ORDINANCE SETTING ASIDE THE SUM OF P136.00 OUT OF THE UNAPPROPRIATED FUNDS OF QUEZON CITY TO COVER THE RENTALS OF A TELEPHONE EXTENSION IN THE OFFICE OF THE DISTRICT SUPERVISOR OF CITY SCHOOLS AND OF THE TELEPHONE INSTALLED AT THE SAN FRANCISCO DEL MONTE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

Section 1. The amount of P136.00 is hereby appropriated out of the unappropriated funds of Quezon City for the following:

1. For the rentals of a telephone extension in the Office of the District Supervisor of City Schools, Quezon City .. P 40.00
  2. For additional appropriation for the rentals of the telephone installed at the San Francisco del Monte Elementary School ..... 96.00
- TOTAL ..... P136.00

Section 2. The amount set aside in this Ordinance shall cover the telephone rentals of said telephones up to June 30, 1941.

Section 3. The sum set aside in this Ordinance shall be spent solely for the specific purpose for which authorized and for no other.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
