ORDINANCE Numbered 130

ORDINANCE SETTING ASIDE THE SUM OF P750.00 OR SO MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE NECESSARY, OUT OF ANY FUNDS OF QUEZON CITY NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED, TO COVER THE DIFFERENCE IN SALARY OF THE CITY ENGINEER CORRESPONDING TO THE PERIOD FROM JANUARY 1 TO JUNE 30, 1941, INCLUSIVE, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TREASURER TO ADVANCE THE FULL AMOUNT OF THE MONTHLY SALARY OF THE CITY ENGINEER AND TO CHARGE AND COLLECT THREE-FOURTHS (3/4) THEREOF FROM THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC WORKS.

WHEREAS, Mr. Ponciano A. Bernarde has been appointed ad interim by His Excellency, the President, as City Engineer of Quezon City.

WHEREAS, under Ordinance No. 55 a salary of P6,000.00 was authorized for the said position of City Engineer but no appropriation was attached to the same;

WHEREAS, the City Engineer is at present receiving a salary of P4,500.00 from the Insular Funds;

WHEREAS, the City Mayor has informed the City Council that he had an understanding with the Honorable, the Undersecretary of Public Works and Communications to the effect that the Bureau of Public Works will continue the payment of the said salary of P4,500.00 per annum and that the Quezon City would be willing to pay the difference of P1,500.00;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City that:

Section 1. The sum of P750.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby set aside out of any funds of Quezon City not otherwise appropriated, to cover the difference in salary of the City Engineer corresponding to the period from January 1 to June 30, 1941, inclusive.

Section 2. The City Treasurer is hereby authorized to advance the full amount of the monthly salary of the City Engineer and to charge and collect three-fourths (3/4) of the amount thereof from the Bureau of Public Works.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective as of January 21, 1941, the date when Mr. Ponciano A. Bernarde assumed the said Position of City Engineer of Quezon City.
