ORDINANCE Numbered 142

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE OF CARABAO MEAT IN THE
PUBLIC MARKETS OF QUEZON CITY.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City,
that:

SECTION 1. Meat Sections- In case of beef and carabao meat, two separate sections of the market shall be assigned to the vendors thereof. No carabao meat shall be introduced, placed, exposed, stored, mixed or kept in any stall in the section assigned for beef, and vice versa. Mixing of both kinds of meat shall not be allowed. Neither shall carabao meat be permitted to be mixed with beef or pork in sausage making.

SEC. 2. Sign Posting- Proper signboards shall be posted by the market authorities in conspicuous places of the sections for beef and carabao meat, stating the kind of meat authorized for sale in each section. At the discretion of the market authorities, any available vacant stall in any part of the market may be assigned for the sale of carabao meat.

SEC. 3. Vendors' Privileges- Any vendor of beef, who is a regular stall holder, may be permitted to sell, through an assistant, carabao meat at any available stall in the section assigned for the said kind of meat.

SEC. 4. Penalty- Any person, stall holder, helper or his duly authorized representative violating any of the foregoing provisions shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten pesos nor more than two hundred pesos or by imprisonment for not less than ten days nor more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the Court.

SEC. 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
