ORDINANCE Numbered 157

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITIONS OF TWO ADDITIONAL MOTORCYCLE COPS AT THE RATE OF EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY PESOS PER ANNUM EACH, AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY PESOS TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE SALARIES OF SAID POSITIONS AND FOR THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN POLICE EQUIPMENT.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created the positions of two additional motorcycle cops at the rate of eight hundred forty pesos per annum each.

SEC. 2. The sum of one thousand five hundred fifty pesos, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds existing in the city treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be made available as follows:

Salary of the two additional motorcycle cops at ₱840 per annum each from April 17 to June 30, 1941 ---- ₱ 35.00

Purchase of one Harley-Davidson motorcycle, latest model, completely equipped for police work ..... 1,100.00

Purchase of two revolvers, with holsters and belts ..... 100.00

TOTAL ..... ₱1,550.00

SEC. 3. The matter of filling these new positions and the purchase of the motorcycle and the necessary equipment is hereby left to the discretion of the City Mayor if the exigencies of the service so warrant.

SEC. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
