ORDINANCE Numbered 159

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE OPENING OF EIGHT ADDITIONAL INTERMEDIATE CLASSES IN QUEZON CITY AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF THREE THOUSAND PESOS FOR THE EXPENSES THAT WILL BE INCURRED THEREBY, AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Division Superintendent of Schools has informed the City Council that in order to accommodate all the school children of Quezon City who have finished the primary course last March there is need for the opening of eight additional intermediate classes next June;

WHEREAS, for this purpose the amount of fifteen thousand nine hundred pesos and ten centavos is necessary for their operation and maintenance;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. The opening of eight additional intermediate classes in Quezon City is hereby authorized.

SEC. 2. The sum of three thousand pesos, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds existing in the city treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the expenses that will be incurred in the opening of the said eight additional intermediate classes, including salaries and wages, rentals, equipment and supplies, and for sundries, said amount to be available up to the end of the present fiscal year 1940-1941.

SEC. 3. The balance to complete the sum of fifteen thousand nine hundred pesos and ten centavos is hereby left to be appropriated by the City Council, the same to be included in the next annual budget for the fiscal year 1941-1942.

SEC. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
