ORDINANCE Numbered 167

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF TWO ELECTRIC LIGHTS, ONE AT THE CORNER OF BOSTON AND MANHATTAN STREETS AND THE OTHER AT THE CORNER OF BOSTON AND VANCHOVER STREETS, AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF SEVEN PESOS TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE ELECTRICAL CONSUMPTION THEREOF DURING THE MONTH OF JUNE, 1941.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. The installation of one electric light at the corner of Boston and Manhattan streets and another at the corner of Boston and Vancouver streets is hereby authorized.

SEC. 2. The sum of seven pesos, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds existing in the city treasury not otherwise appropriated, to pay for the electrical consumption of said lights during the month of June, 1941.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
