ORDINANCE Numbered 174

ORDINANCE SETTING ASIDE THE SUM OF FIVE HUNDRED SEVEN PESOS OUT OF ANY UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE FROM THE INTERNAL REVENUE ALLOTMENT FOR STREETS AND BRIDGES FUND TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE ROADS IN ROSARIO HEIGHTS AND CUBAO HEIGHTS NOW THE PROPERTY OF QUEZON CITY.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. The sum of five hundred seven pesos, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby set aside out of any unappropriated balance from the Internal Revenue Allotment for streets and bridges fund existing in the city treasury, to be made available for the maintenance of the roads in Rosario Heights and Cubao Heights now the property of Quezon City.

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
