ORDINANCE Numbered 177

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF THE POSITIONS OF TWO SPECIAL POLICEMEN IN THE OFFICE OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE, AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED SIXTY PESOS TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE PAYMENT OF THEIR SALARIES AND FOR THE ACQUISITION OF TWO REVOLVERS, COMPLETE WITH BELTS AND HOLSTERS, FOR THEIR USE:

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. There are hereby created the positions of two special policemen in the Office of the Chief of Police whose principal duty shall be to take charge of the catching of astray animals in the streets and other public places in Quezon City, with salary of forty-five pesos each per month.

SEC. 2. The sum of one hundred sixty pesos, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds existing in the city treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be made available for the payment of the salaries of the said special policemen and for the acquisition of two revolvers, complete with belts and holsters, for their use.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
