ORDINANCE NUMBERED 200

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF FIVE HUNDRED PESOS TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE REPAIR AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE STREET CONNECTING THE ROAD TO BALARA, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the street connecting the road to Balara leading to the only artesian well in that vicinity and which is the only road available for the people residing in that place to transport their commodities is in bad condition;

WHEREAS, the City Council realizes the importance of repairing the said street;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. The sum of five hundred pesos, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds existing in the city treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be made available for the repair and construction of the said street.

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
