ORDINANCE NO. SP- **3062**, S-2021

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING ADDITIONAL INCENTIVE TO ALL QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES INCLUDING CONTRACT-OF-SERVICE, JOB ORDERS AND CONSULTANTS IN THE AMOUNT OF TEN THOUSAND PESOS (PHP10,000.00), TO BE TAKEN FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT.

WHEREAS, last June 2021, and for the first time in its history, the Quezon City Government has earned an "unqualified opinion" from the Commission on Audit (COA) for its annual audit report for the year 2020. The unqualified opinion is the highest audit opinion that COA can render to a government agency including a local government unit;

WHEREAS, with the sound financial management of the city, it is high time that the salaries of employees must be taken into consideration;

WHEREAS, due to increase in the prices of basic commodities, as well as the constant threat of COVID-19 pandemic, the grant of additional incentive to all Quezon City Government employees is imperative and of utmost necessity in consideration of the various achievements of the city government for 2020 and 2021 despite the challenges.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. An additional incentive is hereby granted to all Quezon City Government employees including all contract-of-service, job orders and consultants in the Quezon City Government in the amount of Ten Thousand Pesos (Php10,000.00).

SECTION 2. The amount necessary to cover this additional incentive is hereby appropriated to be taken from any available funds of the city.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
