ORDINANCE NO. SP- **3073**, S-2021

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING A NEW TRAFFIC SCHEME OF BARANGAY QUIRINO 2-A, DISTRICT III ADOPTING THE EXISTING ORDINANCES OF QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Section 458 (a)(5)(v) and (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", provides for the Powers, Duties, Functions of the Sangguniang Panlungsod:

- (v) Regulate the use of streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, bridges, parks and other public places and approve the construction, improvement, repair and maintenance of the same, xxx...
- (vi) Regulate traffic on all streets and bridges; prohibit encroachments or obstacles thereon and, when necessary in the interest of public welfare, xxx...";

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WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Quirino 2-A passed Resolution No. 18, Series of 2021, entitled "A Resolution Requesting the Honorable Councilor Wencerom Benedict C. Lagumbay of 3rd District, Quezon City to Sponsor the Proposed One-Way Traffic Management of Barangay Quirino 2-A, District III, Quezon City";

WHEREAS, in accordance with the General Welfare Clause of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the safety and well-being of the barangay shall be the first in barangay governance;

WHEREAS, the increase of vehicular traffic and the seemingly stunted and increasing breadth of the barangay thoroughfares, streets, avenues, boulevards and alleys are further constricted by the wanton and indisciplined parking and/or stalling of vehicles along these roadways;

WHEREAS, there was an increase in the number of vehicles passing through Barangay Quirino 2-A which cause continuous traffic problem within its streets, taking also into consideration the numerous commercial establishments situated in the said barangay;

WHEREAS, there is a necessity to implement a new traffic scheme to prevent chaos and to maintain peace and order in the community and streets within Barangay Quirino 2-A.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. TITLE. - This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the "New Traffic Scheme of Barangay Quirino 2-A."

SECTION 2. COVERAGE. - All motorists, residents and non-residents passing through the streets of Barangay Quirino 2-A are required to obey this new Barangay Traffic Scheme.

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SECTION 3. The New Traffic Schemes are the following:

A) Streets with one-way traffic flow:

- 1. Bignay Street one way going to Anonas Street.*
- 2. Pajo Street is one-way from Anonas Street to Bignay Street.*
- 3. Naranghita Street is one-way from Chico Street to Anonas Street.*
- 4. Lanzones Street is one-way from Anonas Street to Chico Street.*
- 5. Marang Street from Anonas street to Chico street*

B) Streets with two-way traffic flow:

- 1. Chico Street is two-way.*
- 2. Kubili Street is two-way.*
- 3. Rimas Street*
- 4. Caimito Street (dead-end)*

SECTION 4. PENALTIES. - All penalties, fines or surcharges to be imposed shall be the same as those prescribed under Ordinance No. SP-1444, Series of 2004 for motor vehicle violations.

SECTION 5. DEPUTATION. - Authorized personnel to implement this Ordinance are:

- a. Punong Barangay*
- b. Barangay Kagawad (Chairperson, Committee on Peace and Order)*
- c. Barangay Public Safety Officer (BPSO)*
- d. City Deputized Personnels*

The implementation of this Ordinance shall be on a 24/7 basis unless there is a need to suspend the same in particular areas only for reasons of emergencies like fire, calamities, disasters and fiesta or special occasions.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. - All ordinances, resolutions, executive orders, memorandum circulars and all other issuances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. - If for any reason, any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other parts or provisions hereof not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
