AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. SP-2987, S-2020, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE MANDATING STRICT OBSERVANCE OF MINIMUM HEALTH PROTOCOLS BY PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC" IN LIGHT OF THE DECLARATION OF ALERT LEVEL 1 IN THE NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION.
