ORDINANCE NO. SP- **3150**, S-2022

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING THE EXCELLENCE IN GOVERNANCE INCENTIVE TO ALL QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES INCLUDING CONTRACT-OF-SERVICE, JOB ORDERS AND CONSULTANTS IN THE AMOUNT OF TEN THOUSAND PESOS (PHP10,000.00) EACH, TO BE TAKEN FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT.

WHEREAS, in grateful recognition of the invaluable contribution of all the officials and employees of the city government in the collective pursuit of excellence in public service and unwavering commitment to good governance that led to an abundant harvest of distinctions, it is but fitting to grant them the said incentive;

WHEREAS, such additional incentive will further motivate the Quezon City Hall employees, job orders, contracts-of-service, and consultants to continue faithfully serving our constituents in the coming years.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. An additional incentive is hereby granted to all Quezon City Government employees including all contract-of-service, job orders and consultants in the Quezon City Government in the amount of Ten Thousand Pesos (Php10,000.00) each.

SECTION 2. The amount necessary to cover this additional incentive amounting to One Hundred Ninety Million Pesos (Php190,000,000.00) is hereby appropriated to be taken from any available funds of the City.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
