ORDINANCE NO. SP- 3178, S-2023

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A MONTHLY INCENTIVE ALLOWANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (PHP500.00) EACH TO ALL THE REGULAR BARANGAY PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS (BPSO) OF THE ONE HUNDRED FORTY-TWO (142) BARANGAYS IN QUEZON CITY FOR THE YEARS 2023-2025, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. SP-2992, S-2020 was enacted on December 7, 2020, during the 50th Regular Session of the 21st City Council;

WHEREAS, said Ordinance provides for a monthly incentive allowance in the amount of Five Hundred Pesos (Php500.00) each to all the regular Barangay Public Safety Officers (BPSOs) of the 142 barangays in Quezon City for the years 2020-2022;

WHEREAS, the aforementioned Ordinance have been duly approved and enacted, and funding was made available through the budget of the Office of the City Mayor, and included in the Quezon City Peace and Order and Public Safety Plan (POPS Plan) for the years 2020-2022, as Certified by the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG);

WHEREAS, the monthly incentive granted in the aforementioned Ordinance shall likewise be given to all regular BPSOs of the 142 barangays in Quezon City for the years 2023-2025;

WHEREAS, the funding shall likewise be made available through the budget of the Office of the City Mayor;

WHEREAS, the grant of said incentive allowance is one of the programs included in the Quezon City POPS Plan for the years 2023-2025, as Certified by the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG).

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. - This Ordinance shall be known as the "BPSO Incentive Ordinance for Years 2023-2025."

SECTION 2. COVERAGE. - All regular BPSOs shall mean those designated and under plantilla position of the 142 barangays in Quezon City. They shall be entitled to a monthly incentive allowance of Php500.00, for the years 2023-2025, which will be released by the City on a quarterly basis.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. - The funds necessary for the grant of the monthly incentive allowance shall be taken from the budget of the Office of the City Mayor and shall be included in the annual budget for the succeeding years.

SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. - In case any of the provisions of this City Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions hereof, which are not affected thereby, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. - All ordinances, resolutions, local executive orders, rules and regulations, or any part thereof inconsistent herewith, are deemed repealed, modified, and amended accordingly.
