ORDINANCE NO. SP- 618 S-96

AN ORDINANCE WITHDRAWING THE ONE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED SIXTY ONE (1,361) SQUARE METER LOT DESCRIBED AS LOT 16, BLK. 40, PSD 61418, LOCATED ALONG RALANG CREEK, BETWEEN ROOSEVELT AVENUE AND LAMUTAN STREET, BARANGAY VETERANS VILLAGE, AND COVERED BY TRANSFER CERTIFICATE OF TITLE NO. 262152 OF THE OFFICE OF THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OF QUEZON CITY, FROM ITS PRESENT STATUS AS AN OPEN SPACE FOR PUBLIC USE TO PRIVATE.

WHEREAS, Lot 16, Blk. 40, Psd 61418 is an open space consisting of one thousand three hundred sixty one (1,361) square meters covered and embraced by Transfer Certificate of Tittle No. 262132 of the Office of the Register of Deeds of Quezon City and registered in the name of the Quezon City government ;

WHEREAS, a portion of said lot has been occupied by Amelia Aban through her predecessor-in-interest since 1946;

WHEREAS, the said vacant lot has been reserved for the purpose of accommodating the septic tank of the NAWASA which had since been abandoned;

WHEREAS, no landowner nor residents of Project 7, Quezon City, where the property is located will be prejudiced by the withdrawal of the said lot from its status as public property of the Quezon City government and the conversion thereof into a residential lot.
