AN ORDINANCE RE-CLASSIFYING EIGHT (8) REGULAR PLANTILLA POSITIONS OF ACCOUNTING CLERK IV (SG-10) AND UPGRADING THIRTEEN (13) REGULAR PLANTILLA POSITIONS OF ACCOUNTING CLERK III (SG-8) UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE CITY TREASURER, QUEZON CITY, TO ACCOUNTS ANALYST (SG-11) AND ACCOUNTING CLERK IV (SG-10), RESPECTIVELY, AND PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, Section 458 (a) (1) (viii) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", empowers the Sangguniang Panlungsod to wit:

"Approve ordinances and pass resolutions necessary for an efficient and effective city government and in this connection shall determine the positions and the salaries and wages, allowances and other emoluments and benefits of officials and employees paid wholly or mainly from the City funds and provide for expenditures necessary for the proper conduct of programs, projects, services and activities of the city government."

WHEREAS, the employees concerned had requested the City Council through this representation to upgrade their present positions taking into considerations the duties and responsibilities they had performed in a supervisory status;

WHEREAS, there is a need to upgrade these positions to avoid overlapping of authority, determine the specific duties and responsibilities, and to attain a clear perspective of the department's organizational set-up, provided it conforms with the index of occupational services, position titles and salary grades issued by the Department of Budget and Management through Compensation and Position Classification Bureau dated July 31, 1997;
