ORDINANCE NO. SP- 734, \$-98

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL SERVICES OFFICE IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC ORDER AND SAFETY (DPOS) AND THE SANGGUNIANG SERGEANT-AT-ARMS TO DESIGNATE CERTAIN AREA OF THE QUEZON CITY HALL COMPOUND AS PARKING AREA AND TO TAKE APPROPRIATE MEASURE FOR THE EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION HEREOF.

WHEREAS, it is an accepted practice, both in government and private offices, to provide their duly elected officials and top management executives with appropriate parking spaces;

WHEREAS, members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod usually spend their early hours attending to the needs of their constituents that when they arrived in City Hall building they are experiencing the difficulty of looking for a convenient parking space;

## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. The General Services Office is hereby authorized in consultation with the Department of Public Order and Safety and the Sangguniang Sergeant-At-Arms, to designate certain area of the Quezon City Hall Compound as parking area.

SECTION 2. A Committee is hereby created to be headed by the Chief of the General Services Office that shall take charge in the preparation of the lay out plans.

SECTION 3. The City General Service Office, the Sangguniang Sergeant-At-Arms and the Department of Public Order and Safety are hereby directed to take appropriate measures for the effective implementation of this Ordinance.
