Ordinance No. 3P- 755 75-1999

AN ORDINANCE SUSPENDING FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) MONTHS THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ORDINANCE NO SP-651, S-98, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING OWNERS OPERATORS, LESSES, OCCUPANTS AND CONCESSIONAIRES OF BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS, CONTRACTORS AND DEVELOPERS AND PERSONS REQUIRED TO SECURE BUSINESS AND/OR BUILDING PERMITS IN DOING BUSINESS OR UNDER-TAKING CONSTRUCTION OR REPAIR WORK IN QUEZON CITY TO SECURE PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE, PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES", FOR THE PURPOSE OF REVIEW.

WHEREAS, there is a need for review of the Ordinance to make it more attuned to the ongoing economic crisis of our country and so so not to further hamper the growth of our business community;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. The implementation of Ordinance No. SP-651, S-98, is hereby suspended for a period of three (3) months for the purpose of review.
