RESOLUTION NO. 7816, S-99

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING ONE-SIDE PARKING IN CERTAIN STREETS OF BARANGAY E. RODRIGUEZ, SR., AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code provides that:

"Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants".

WHEREAS, the barangay government of E. Rodriguez, Sr., passed Barangay Resolution No. 46, S-97, entitled "A resolution strongly urging the City Council to pass an Ordinance allowing only one-side parking in certain streets of Barangay E. Rodriguez, Sr., with penalties in violation thereof;

WHEREAS, use of both sides of the streets for parking creates traffic bottlenecks, unnecessary delays and loss of precious man-hours considering the width of the road and the volume of vehicles passing through Barangay E. Rodriguez, Sr.;

WHEREAS, residents of the area are affected by the irresponsible parking of vehicles on both sides of the streets even on driveways especially by non-residents of Barangay E. Rodriguez, Sr.;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay enacted an ordinance regulating the parking of vehicles in certain streets of the Barangay, and allowing one side parking in answer to various complaints of residents who are affected by irresponsibly parked vehicles on both sides of the streets even on driveways;
