ORDINANCE NO. SP- 799, S-99

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ALL CINEMA OWNERS AND OPERATORS TO INCREASE TICKET PRICES BY ONE PESO (P1.00) DURING THE MONTH OF OCTOBER, 1999 FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUPPORTING THE SCOUT EXCHANGE PROGRAM OF THE QUEZON CITY BOY SCOUTS COUNCIL WITH THE CHIBA CITY COUNCIL OF JAPAN TO BE HELD FROM DECEMBER 1999 TO 2000.

WHEREAS, in fulfillment of the Sister City relationship between Quezon City and Chiba City in Japan, there is an existing Memorandum of Agreement between the Quezon City Council of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP), and the Chiba City Council of the Boy Scouts of Nippon (BSN) which promotes a continuous learning program among member scouts of both councils;

WHEREAS, included in this agreement is an exchange program wherein both councils exchange scouts delegates every year for the continuous promotion of educational, cultural and technical skills learning aspects of the scouting program;

WHEREAS, in the true spirit of the scouting movement and world brotherhood, this program will celebrate its platinum anniversary (20th year) with the 10th Memorial Scout Exchange Program from December 1999 to May 2000;

WHEREAS, the Japanese delegation will be coming for their Philippine visit on December 24-31, 1999, and install their monument commemorating the twenty years of the scout exchange program within the Quezon City Hall grounds as their gesture of brotherhood and friendship, in addition to other activities of the program;
