ORDINANCE NO. SP- 953 S-2000

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL CINEMA OWNERS AND OPERATORS IN QUEZON CITY TO INCREASE THEIR THEATER ADMISSION FEE BY ONE PESO (P1.00) COVERING THE PERIOD FROM DECEMBER 1-15, 2000, TO SUPPORT THE PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES OF THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL RED CROSS, QUEZON CITY CHAPTER.

WHEREAS, the Philippine National Red Cross, Quezon City Chapter (PNRC-QC) has been continually in the forefront of promoting medical services and other forms of care and welfare activities to people who ask for its involvement;

WHEREAS, the PNRC-QC has, as of date, been operating on a deficit due to the high cost of blood testing re-agents;

WHEREAS, requiring cinema owners and operators to increase their theater admission fee by One Peso (P1.00) for a certain period has already been done early this year, where one of the beneficiaries of such activity was the Boy Scouts of the Philippines.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED.

SECTION 1. All cinema owners and operators within Quezon City are hereby required to increase their theater admission fee by One Peso (P1.00) covering the period from December 1-15, 2000, to be remitted to the Philippine National Red Cross Quezon City Chapter (PNRC-QC) or its duly authorized agents/representatives.

SECTION 2. All proceeds of this fund raising activity shall be used solely to finance the programs and activities of the PNRC-QC, and a corresponding financial report shall be submitted to the City Council on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Week of December 2000 for its information.

SECTION 3. All tax-exempt activities and measures for this year, as may be appealed by PNRC-QC Chapter to the City Council for sponsorship and enactment shall be negated by this Ordinance.
