AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE INDICATIVE PLAN PROPOSED BY NATIONAL GOVERNMENT CENTER EAST SIDE DEVELOPMENT PROMISE MANAGEMENT BOARD AS PER PROCLAMATION NO. 1169, S. 1998 MEMORANDUM ORDER NO. 76, S-1999 CONVERTING SOME PORTUBLE THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT CENTER WITHIN BARANGAYS LATER HILLS, COMMONWEALTH, AND PAYATAS, ALL OF QUEZON COVERING AN AREA OF APPROXIMATELY TWO MILLION THE HUNDRED EIGHTY THOUSAND SQUARE METERS (2,380,006 SQ.M.) PURPOSES AS DESCRIBED IN THE PLAN SUBJECT TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF PRESCRIBED UNDER QUEZON CITY ORDINANCE NO. SP-56, B-13 BATAS PAMBANSA BLG. 220.

WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution mandates the state to undertain cooperation with the private sector, a continuing program of Urban Land Refer housing which will make available at affordable cost decent housing services to underprivileged and homeless citizens in urban centers and recess;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code (R.A. 7160) empowers the Council to process and approve subdivision plans for residential, complement industrial and other development purposes;

WHEREAS, the Project Management Board (PMB) through the Project (NGC-EDP) under the Presidential Commission for the Urban Propert (PC) proposed an Indicative Plan for the portions of the NGC site as applicable Proclamation No. 1169, S-1998, covering areas in Barangays Boards (PC).

whereas, in order to attain the constitutional mandate to make affordable to all as well as the policy of the government to eradicate syndicates, it is imperative to approve the proposed Indicative Plan.
