ORDINANCE NO. SP- 976, S-2000

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR, ISMAEL A. MATHAY, JR., TO EXPROPRIATE THE PARCELS OF LAND SITUATED AT BANLAT, QUEZON CITY, IDENTIFIED AS LOT 10 46-A WITH AN AREA OF ONE THOUSAND (1,000) SQUARE METERS AND LOT 46 B-1 WITH AN AREA OF FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY (550) SQUARE METERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ERECTING THE TANDANG SORA SHRINE AND THE RELEASE OF FUNDS NEEDED THEREFOR TO BE TAKEN FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR.

WHEREAS, Melchora Aquino, popularly known as Tandang Sora during the Spanish-Filipino civil war, led the insurrectos in one revolt against the Spanish colonizers;

WHEREAS, in giving recognition to her courage and sense of nationalism, it is necessary to erect a shrine dedicated to her at Banlat, where she was raised;

WHEREAS, the place where the Tandang Sora Shrine shall be constructed is in Banlat on a One Thousand square meters (1,000 sq.m.) lot known as Lot 10 46-A which is, on record, in the name of Ms. Barbara Calixto and the access road leading to the shrine consisting of Five Hundred Fifty square meters (550 sq.m.) known as Lot 10 46-B-1 which is, on record, in the name of Ms. Lourdes Valdez;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. The City Mayor is hereby authorized to expropriate the parcel of land known as Lot 10 46-A consisting of One Thousand (1,000) square meters, on record, owned by Ms. Barbara Calixto, where the Tandang Sora Shrine will be erected.

SECTION 2. The City Mayor is further authorized to expropriate the parcel of land known as Lot 10 46-B-1 consisting of Five Hundred Fifty (550) square meters, on record, owned by Ms. Lourdes Valdez, that will serve as an access road going to the shrine.
