ORDINANCE NO. SP- 1068, S-2001

AN ORDINANCE ADJUSTING THE RATE IMPOSED IN ORDINANCE NO. NC-124, S-89, AS AMENDED, FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BUSINESS REGISTRATION PLATES TO ALL BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS AND OCCUPATIONAL UNDERTAKINGS WITH A FIXED PLACE OF OPERATION WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF QUEZON CITY, VALID FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE (5) YEARS EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2002.

Introduced by Councilor FRANZ S. PUMAREN.

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. NC-124, S-89, as amended, which was introduced by Hon. Alberto M. Galarpe and enacted by the City Council on December 19. 1982 provides that all business establishments and occupational undertakings with a fixed situation of operation in the City are required to register and secure a "Business Permit Registration Plate" after a business permit is secured, prior to the start of any business operation undertaking;

WHEREAS, Section 3(3) and (5) of the same ordinance states, among others.

"xxx the Business Permit Registration Plate may be used for a period of five (5) replaceable thereafter and the cost of the Business Permit Registration Plate and the printed validation sticker shall be paid by the permittee xxx";

WHEREAS, besides the need to cover the production cost of the business penning registration plate, there is a need to adjust the rate provided in Ordinance NC-124, S-89, as amended, in order to cover the expenses the city shall incur for the proper inspection regulation of all business establishments existing within the territorial jurisdiction of Ouezon City;

WHEREAS, so much time had lapsed from the period of its first implementation, that some establishments operating then and were issued Business Permit Registration. Plates are now inoperative, have changed their classification or transferred elsewhere, and the plates that were issued unto them have fallen into unscrupulous hands and are being utilized to evade and deceive license inspectors thereby allowing the illegal operation of their businesses and defrauding the City government of due revenues;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. The Business Permits and Licensing Office (BPLO) is hereby granted authority to collect two hundred fifty pesos (P250.00) from every business establishment.
