WHEREAS, Section 9, Article II of the 1987 Constitution declares that the State shall promote a just and dynamic social order that will ensure the prosperity and independence of the nation and free the people from poverty, through policies that provide adequate social services, promote full employment, arising standard of living and an improved quality of life for all;

WHEREAS. Section 9 Article XIII of the 1987 Constitution declares that the State shall, by law, and for the common good, undertake, in cooperation with the private sector, a continuing program of urban land reform and housing which will make available at affordable cost decent housing and basic services to underprivileged and homeless citizens in urban centers and resettlement areas;

WHEREAS Section 10, Article XIII of the 1987 Constitution declares that urban or rural poor dwellers shall not be evicted nor their dwellings demolished, except in accordance with law and in a just and humane manner;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7279 or the Urban Development and Housing Act (UDHA) ordains local government units to carry out socialized housing programs and enforce just and humane eviction and demolition policies within their respective localities;
