ORDINANCE NO. SP- 1170, S-2002

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE OWNERS, MANAGERS AND/OR OPERATORS OF NIGHTCLUB, COCKTAIL LOUNGE, BAR, BEERHOUSE, PUBHOUSE, KARAOKE/SING-ALONG CLUB OR OTHER SIMILAR ESTABLISHMENTS OPERATING WITHIN QUEZON CITY TO EMPLOY LICENSED SECURITY GUARDS TO MAINTAIN PEACE AND ORDER INSIDE THEIR PREMISES, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Section 458 (4) (vii) of R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Government through an ordinance enacted for the purpose, shall:

"Regulate the establishment, operation and maintenance of any entertainment or amusement facilities, xxx particularly those which tend to disturb the community or annoy the inhabitants, or require the suspension or suppression of the same xxx"

WHEREAS, reports from barangay officials reveal that the influx of nightspots in their territorial jurisdiction, particularly those in the slum areas, often creates trouble and violence caused by unruly customers/clientele;

WHEREAS, customers carrying firearms and deadly weapons are frequently unchecked due to the absence of competent security guards who are suppose to conduct the necessary body search and inspection before a customer is allowed to enter the premises of the said establishments;
