ORDINANCE NO. SP-1179, S-2002

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE QUEZON CITY MUSEUM UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXHIBITING THE HISTORICAL, CULTURAL AND NATURAL ASSETS OF THE CITY, AND APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF TEN MILLION PESOS (P10,000.000.00) FOR THE PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, at present, there is no museum or venue within Quezon City designated for demonstration or exhibition of the historical, political, cultural and natural assets of the city;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 292, provides for the protection, maintenance and preservation of historical, cultural and natural assets which are considered tourist attractions;

WHEREAS, Section 17 (b) (3) (X11) of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides;

"Local Government units shall provide x x x

- (b) Such basic services and facilities include, but are not limited to, the following  $x \times x$
- xii. Tourism development and promotion programs."

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. The Quezon City Museum is hereby established under the Office of the City Mayor. The Quezon City Museum shall house and exhibit the historical, cultural and natural assets of the City.
