ORDINANCE NO. SP-**1182**S-2002

AN ORDINANCE RENAMING ISMAEL A. MATHAY, SR. HIGH SCHOOL TORO HILLS ANNEX TO PUGAD LAWIN HIGH SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, Section 13, paragraph (B) sub-paragraph (3) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, expressly provides that the sanggunian of highly urbanized cities and of component cities whose charters prohibit their voters from voting for provincial elective officials, hereinafter referred to in this Code as independent component cities, may, in consultation with the Philippine Historical Commission, change the name of public elementary, secondary and vocational or technical schools, community colleges and non-chartered colleges;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council had enacted and passed an ordinance separating Ismael A. Mathay, Sr. High School Toro Hills Annex from the mother school after the former complied with the requirements as provided for under DECS Order No. 5, 1989;

WHEREAS, no less than the DECS Secretary Raul S. Roco had approved the separation thereof including the changing of the name from Ismael A. Mathay, Sr. High School Toro Hills Annex to Pugad Lawin High School in his 9<sup>th</sup> Indorsement dated August 28, 2001;

WHEREAS, the renaming of the school into Pugad Lawin High School is highly significant not only that it is situated within and/or near the site of the Cry of Pugad Lawin Shrine, but also a realization of a dream come true of our forefathers who nurtured freedom and education to all Filipinos.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN  
SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. The Ismael A. Mathay, Sr. High School Toro Hills Annex is hereby renamed to Pugad Lawin High School.
