AN ORDINANCE GRANTING BENEFITS AND EMOLUMENTS TO ALL SANGGUNIANG KABATAANG KAGAWADS  $^{\circ}$ **OUEZON** PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 77 (5) (b-4) OF THE IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991.

WHEREAS, Section 13, Article 2 of the 1987 Constitution provides that, "the State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being. It shall inculcate in the youth patriotism and nationalism, and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs;"

WHEREAS, Article 77 (5) (b-4) of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates that, "The Sangguniang Kabataan Officials shall have the same privileges enjoyed by other Sangguniang Barangay Officials under the Code, subject to such requirements and limitations provided in these Rules. xxx,"

WHEREAS, all duly elected kagawad of the Sanggurdang Kabataan have been deprived of their emoluments/allowances and other non-monetary benefits contrary to the provisions of the Local Government Code and its implementing rules as above-cited:

WHEREAS, these empluments/benefits and other non-monetary benefits will serve as incentive to the valuable services and contributions rendered or to be rendered by these elected youth officials in the pursuit of excellence for the youth of their barangay and the community in general;

WHEREAS, in recognition of their vital role in the barangay and the community, it is necessary that they receive these benefits due their positions.
