## ORDINANCE NO. SP-1204 S, 2002

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING BARANGAY LENGTH OF SERVICE BENEFITS/INCENTIVES TO ALL ELECTED OFFICIALS AFTER THEIR TENURE OF OFFICE.

WHEREAS, barangay officials are the frontliners in government service as the barangay serves as the primary planning and implementing unit of government policies, plans, projects, programs and activities of the national and city government;

WHEREAS, after their termine, barangay officials are left abandoned by the government although they are entitled to an equivalent civil service eligibility very few of them invoke their preference in government service as provided for in the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, granting them incentives on the basis of their length of service will boost their morale after their tenure and such financial incentives could somehow help them, taking into account the economic and social status of barangay officials.

## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Elected officials after their tenure of office shall be entitled to a financial incentive of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) per year of service
