AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE DEADLINE FOR THE PAYMENT OF BUSINESS TAXES AND FEES FROM JANUARY 20, 2003 TO JANUARY 31, 2003.

WHEREAS, in view of the limitations of the existing manpower and facilities of the City Treasurer to accommodate the large number of taxpayers paying their business taxes and fees for year 2003, the first quarter payment period from January 1 to 20, is deemed insufficient;

WHEREAS, in the interest of the tax-paying public of Quezon City, the deadline for payments should be extended to at least ten (10) days to accommodate business tax payments without penalty;

WHEREAS, in consideration of the limitations of the present collection system to service the voluminous number of taxpayers, the City may provide for an extended grace period of time to accept payments without penalty, but, likewise, conform within the limits set by existing laws and ordinances.
