ORDINANCE NO. SP-1229, 8-2003

AN ORDINANCE RECLASSIFYING/ CONVERTING THE LAND USE OF A PARCEL OF LAND COVERED BY TRANSFER CERTIFICATE OF TITLE NO. RT-9997 (327996) CONSISTING OF SIX THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE (6,639)SQUARE REGISTERED  $\mathbf{I}\mathbf{N}$ THE NAME OF THE QUEZON GOVERNMENT, AND LOCATED IN BARANGAY SAN ANTONIO, QUEZON CITY, FROM SCHOOL SITE TO DISPOSABLE PROPERTY OR RESIDENTIAL LOT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the city government purchased a parcel of land, particularly lot 5 of the subdivision plan (LRC) Psd-247848, being a portion of land described on plan Psu-55757, LRC Rec. No. 32234 consisting of Six Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-Nine (6,639) square meters, owned by and registered in the name of the Quezon City government, and covered by TCT No. RT-9997 (327996), for school site;

WHEREAS, the above parcel of land at the time it was purchased was occupied by informal settlers way back in 1970, hence, the difficulty in relocating them to other sites conducive for socialized housing program;

WHEREAS, such occupancy did not deprive the residents within the surrounding area of their right to education for reason that there still exists a school within the vicinity;
