ORDINANCE NO. SP1 244, S-2003

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ALL PUBLIC UTILITY JEEPNEYS WITH ROUTE "BAGONG SILANG-NOVALICHES BAYAN" TO USE SUSANO ROAD AFTER AUSTRIA STREET AND INSTEAD DIRECTING ALL SAID JEEPNEYS TO TURN RIGHT AT AUSTRIA STREET TOWARDS GEN. LUIS STREET EXITING AT MILLIONAIRES VILLAGE GOING BACK TO BAGONG SILANG.

WHEREAS, in order to decongest the heavy volume of vehicles using Susano Road, Novaliches, Quezon City, as a solution to the grave and worsening traffic congestion thereat, Mr. Tadeo M. Palma, Special Assistant to the Mayor and Officer-in-Charge of the Novaliches District Center issued a Directive "Declaring all public utility jeepneys with route "Bagong Silang-Novaliches Bayan" to turn right at Sapphire Street, Millionaires Village, to exit at Gen. Luis St., Brgy. Novaliches Proper and to use same route going back to Bagong Silang, Caloocan," effective September 21, 2002, a copy of which is attached as Annex "A" to form integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, after the experimental stage it appears that the directive of Mr. Tadeo M. Palma upon request of the Bagong Silang Jeepney Association needs to be amended allowing the concerned jeepneys to enter the Novaliches Bayan through Austria Street towards Gen. Luis Street and exiting at Millionaires Village going back to Bagong Silang;

WHEREAS, Section 458 (1) of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that the sangguniang panlungsod shall approve ordinances and pass resolutions necessary for an efficient and effective City government, and in this connection, shall:
