ORDINANCE NO. SP. 1266 S-2003

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. SP-1154, S-2002, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DETENTION OF CADAVER OF DECEASED INDIGENT PATIENTS IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, Section 3 of City Ordinance No. SP-1154, S-2002 does not include the prohibition against the withholding or refusal for the issuance of proper death certificate;

WHEREAS, the immediate approval of this amendment by addition is extremely necessary to make City Ordinance No. SP-1154, S-2002 complete and applicable.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. SP-1154, S-2002 is hereby amended, to read as follows:

"SECTION 3. PENALIZED ACT. - IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY HOSPITAL, CLINIC, FUNERAL OTHER HEALTH CARE AND/OR ANY PARLOR. CAUSE. TO OR **ESTABLISHMENT** FACILITY DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, THE DETENTION OF THE WITHHOLDING INCLUDING PROPER DEATH CERTIFICATE OF THE DECEASED NON-PAYMENT FOR INDIGENT PATIENT **EXPENSES** OR. HOSPITAL/MEDICAL BILLS INCURRED WHILE BEING TREATED".
