ORDINANCE NO. SP-**1280**, S-2003th

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE CIVIL REGISTRAR TO SUBMIT TO THE COMMISSION ON ELECTIONS (COMELEC) A MONTHLY LISTING OF DEATH CERTIFICATES INVOLVING CITY RESIDENT VOTERS.

Introduced by Councilors RESTITUTO B. MALAÑGEN, ANTONIO E. INTON, JR., ERIC Z. MEDINA, VOLTAIRE GODOFREDO L. LIBAN III, RAMON P. MEDALLA, MARY ANN L. SUSANO, DANTE M. DE GUZMAN, JORGE L. BANAL, JUNIE MARIE L. CASTELO, ROMMEL R. ABESAMIS, RICARDO R. DEL ROSARIO and ALMA F. MONTILLA.

WHEREAS, it has been observed that there is no formal process by which the names of dead persons are cancelled from the COMELEC list of voters;

WHEREAS, steps should be undertaken to prevent unscrupulous persons from using the names of dead voters for their evil machinations during election time.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:


SECTION 1. The City Civil Registrar of Quezon City is hereby required to submit to the Quezon City Commission on Elections (COMELEC) a monthly listing of death certificates involving City residents of voting age. The COMELEC, upon receipt of such list, shall take judicial notice of the facts of death of the names contained therein.

SECTION 2. Any violation of the provisions of this ordinance by the City Civil Registrar shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00).


SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
