ORDINANCE NO. SP- **1282**, S-2003

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING IN THE ANNUAL BUDGETS OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE CITY COUNCIL AN EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE FUND FOR INDIGENT RESIDENTS AND ALLOCATING THE SUM OF FIVE MILLION PESOS (P5,000,000.00) FOR THE PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, there is a proposed legislative measure making obligatory on the part of funeral parlors and similar establishments the release of cadavers of indigent persons even without paying for the services rendered by them, under penalty of law,

WHEREAS, there should be a corresponding legislative measure to compensate these funeral parlors for services rendered to indigent deceased residents of Quezon City in order that their business may not unduly suffer;

WHEREAS, there are other emergency situations involving indigent residents which need immediate response from their elected representatives.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. There is hereby established in every annual budget of the Quezon City government under the Office of the City Council an Emergency Assistance Fund for Indigent Residents to be used exclusively for the grant of assistance to indigent residents confronted by emergency situations requiring immediate action such as death, illness and other calamitous circumstances.
