AN ORDINANCE RENAMING FRISCO PUBLIC MARKET LOCATED AT ZAMORA STREET, BARANGAY DAMAYAN, QUEZON CITY, TO CONGRESSMAN REYNALDO A. CALALAY PUBLIC MARKET.

WHEREAS, Honorable Reynaldo A. Calalay served as Punong Barangay of Barangay Damayan from 1972 to 1988;

WHEREAS, during his incumbency as Punong Barangay he instituted several infrastructure projects either thru the barangay funds or city funds upon his initiative;

WHEREAS, during his two terms in the Quezon City Council, i.e. from 1988 to 1995, he introduced several ordinances and resolutions, among them were measures beneficial to the community, such as the granting of financial assistance to fire victims, retired employees or those who became disabled during and in the performance of duty, providing seed funds in government hospitals for indigent patients and the construction and renovation of multi-purpose halls, day-care centers and other public buildings;

WHEREAS, it is but fitting to name the Frisco Public Market along Zamora St., Barangay Damayan, Quezon City, in honor of Cong. Calalay who devoted thirty-one (31) years, more or less, of his life in government service as a Punong Barangay, City Councilor and Congressman of Quezon City.
