ORDINANCE NO. SP- **1289**, S-2003

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION IN APPROPRIATE PLACES WITHIN THE CITY HALL BUILDING OF DRINKING FOUNTAINS CERTIFIED AS SAFE BY COMPETENT AUTHORITIES AND PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, while purified or mineral water in bottles or gallons are available in Quezon City Hall, still many employees, due to financial constraint, would rather drink tap water or limit their intake of water well below the nutritional requirements;

WHEREAS, human resources are the most important assets of the nation and the Quezon City government must safeguard the health and well being of its work force and the general public transacting business with Quezon City by providing ample and safe drinking water to them.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Drinking fountains certified as safe by competent authorities are hereby directed to be installed in appropriate places within the Quezon City Hall.
