ORDINANCE NO. SP- **1295**, S-2003

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A TWENTY PERCENT (20%) DISCOUNT ON ALL GOODS AND SERVICES AVAILED OF BY SENIOR CITIZENS ACCREDITED BY THE OFFICE OF THE SENIOR CITIZENS AFFAIRS IN OPTICAL SHOPS AND FUNERAL PARLORS IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, it is only proper and fitting that the City government should recognize the significant role, contributions and achievements of our senior citizens in the community building and development through the grant of benefits not covered by Republic Act 7432, also known as the "Senior Citizens Act."

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:


SECTION 1. All senior citizens accredited with the Office of Senior Citizens Affairs (OSCA) of Quezon City, shall be entitled to a Twenty Percent (20%) discount on all goods and services availed of by them in optical shops and funeral parlors in Quezon City.


