ORDINANCE NO. SP-**1307**, S2003

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING A QUEZON CITY PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT SERVICE OFFICE IN LIEU OF INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS OFFICE TO HANDLE THE EMPLOYMENT PROGRAMS OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT, AS ENACTED BY LAW UNDER RA 8759, PROVIDING FOR ITS FUNCTIONS AND TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF TEN MILLION TWO HUNDRED FORTY-TWO THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED ONE PESOS (P10, 242,301.00) FOR THE INITIAL OPERATION OF THE OFFICE.

WHEREAS, the City government had been endeavoring and committed to strengthen the employment promotion programs toward the upliftment of human resources in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 8759, therefore enacted to institutionalize and expand employment facilitation services through the establishment operation and maintenance of Public Employment Service Office in every province, key cities and other strategic areas throughout the country.
