ORDINANCE NO. SP **1310**, S-2003

AN ORDINANCE ALLOCATING THE AMOUNT OF TWELVE MILLION PESOS (P12M) TO BE TAKEN FROM THE ANNUAL INFRASTRUCTURE FUND FOR THE YEAR 2004 FOR THE IMPROVEMENT AND CONSTRUCTION OF BONE DEPOSITORIES AND APARTMENT-TYPE NICHES AT BAGBAG, BAESA AND NOVALICHES PUBLIC CEMETERIES.

WHEREAS, the existing public cemeteries in Quezon City, particularly Bagbag, Baesa and Novaliches public cemeteries are currently congested and fully-occupied;

WHEREAS, in the attempt to solve the problems of congestion and bone depositories, the City government had initiated the construction of rental bone depositories and apartment-type niches in public cemeteries in the past;

WHEREAS, because of the continuous mortality in Quezon City every year, the existing apartment-type niches and bone depositories remain to be limited and insufficient and, therefore, the problems on congestion and accomodation in public cemeteries still exist;

WHEREAS, the improvement and construction of new bone depositories and apartment-type niches will solve the problems of congestion and accommodation of cadavers especially those that belong to the poor families who want the remains of the members of their families and relative be buried in public cemeteries;
