ORDINANCE RENAMING GRANADA STREET, BARANGAY VALENCIA, QUEZON CITY, TO JOSE O. VERA STREET.

WHEREAS, streets, avenues, boulevards, parks, playgrounds, historical spots and other public places are so named so as to signify and perpetuate the greatness and nobility of certain personage of note, or the significance of certain events:

WHEREAS, Section 13, paragraph b (2) of the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that:

"The sanggunian of highly urbanized cities and component cities whose charters prohibit their voters from voting for provincial elective officials bereinafter referred to in this Code as independent component cities, may, in consultation with Philippine Historical Commission, change the name of the following within its territorial jurisdiction:

- (2) City roads, avenues, boulevards, thorough fares and bridges"
